(Exodus 20:3) Jesus Christ and His Teaching Concerning False Gods: Exodus 20:3 (NASB)

³ "You shall have no other gods before Me.

1. THE TEACHING OF CHRIST

Jesus Christ declared that there is *only one true and living God, One Sovereign LORD and Majesty* of the universe, and that we are to love Him with all our hearts, souls, and minds.

Matthew 22:35-40 (NASB)

³⁵ One of them, a lawyer, asked Him *a question*, testing Him, ³⁶ "Teacher, which is the great commandment in the Law?"

³⁷ And He said to him, " 'YOU SHALL LOVE THE LORD YOUR GOD WITH ALL YOUR HEART, AND WITH ALL YOUR SOUL, AND WITH ALL YOUR MIND.'

³⁸ "This is the great and foremost commandment.

³⁹ "The second is like it, 'YOU SHALL LOVE YOUR NEIGHBOR AS YOURSELF.'

⁴⁰ "On these two commandments depend the whole Law and the Prophets."

¹⁸ For thus says the LORD, who created the heavens (He is the God who formed the earth and made it, He established it *and* did not create it a waste place, *but* formed it to be inhabited), "I am the LORD, and there is none else.

Isaiah 46:9 (NASB)

⁹ "Remember the former things long past, For I am God, and there is no other; *I am* God, and there is no one like Me,

Ephesians 4:6 (NASB)

⁶ One God and Father of all who is over all and through all and in all. 1 Timothy 2:5 (NASB)

⁵ For there is one God, *and* one mediator also between God and men, *the* man Christ Jesus,

2. THE TEACHING OF CHRIST

²⁵ "Truly, truly, I say to you, an hour is coming and now is, when the dead will hear the voice of the Son of God, and those who hear will live.

THE BELIEVER'S RESPONSE
