(Exodus 20:3) Jesus Christ and His Teaching Concerning False Gods:

Exodus 20:3 (NASB)

³ "You shall have no other gods before Me.

3. THE TEACHING OF CHRIST

Jesus Christ declared that God exists by proclaiming that He was One with the Father.

John 10:30 (NASB)

³⁰ "I and the Father are one."

THE BELIEVER'S RESPONSE

1) The only way to have a relationship with the Father is to believe in the Son of God.

2) We must trust in Christ and believe His Word: He and the Father are One.

John 10:37-38 (NASB)

³⁷ "If I do not do the works of My Father, do not believe Me;

³⁸ but if I do them, though you do not believe Me, believe the works, so that you may know and understand that the Father is in Me, and I in the Father."

John 14:10 (NASB)

¹⁰ "Do you not believe that I am in the Father, and the Father is in Me? The words that I say to you I do not speak on My own initiative, but the Father abiding in Me does His works.

John 17:11 (NASB)

¹¹ "I am no longer in the world; and yet they themselves are in the world, and I come to You. Holy Father, keep them in Your name, *the name* which You have given Me, that they may be one even as We are.

John 17:22 (NASB)

²² "The glory which You have given Me I have given to them, that they may be one, just as We are one;

⁵⁸ Jesus said to them, "Truly, truly, I say to you, before Abraham was born, I am."
