## The Doctrine of the Resurrections

(<u>1 Corinthians 3:10-17</u>)

A Walk Bearing God's Nature: The Fruit of the Spirit (7) (Galatians 5:22-23)

1. (<u>Galatians 5:22-23</u>) <u>Holy Spirit— Believer, Walk</u>: the believer is to walk bearing God's nature, that is, the fruit of God's Spirit.

Galatians 5:22-23 (NASB)

<sup>22</sup> But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness,

<sup>3</sup>gentleness, self-control; against such things there is no law.

5. There is the fruit of *gentleness* (*chrēstotēs*): it is "being kind and good, useful and helpful, gentle and sweet, considerate and gracious through all situations no matter the circumstances."

A person who is gentle does not act.....

Gentleness cares for the feelings of others and feels with them. It experiences the full depth of sympathy and empathy. It shows care and gets right into the situation with a person. Gentleness suffers with those who suffer, and struggles with those who struggle, and works with those who work.

<sup>35</sup> But love your enemies, and do good, and lend, expecting nothing in return; and your reward will be great, and you will be sons of the Most High; for He Himself is kind to ungrateful and evil *men*.

### Ephesians 2:4-7 (NASB)

<sup>4</sup> But God, being rich in mercy, because of His great love with which He loved us,

<sup>5</sup> even when we were dead in our transgressions, made us alive together with Christ (by grace you have been saved),

<sup>6</sup> and raised us up with Him, and seated us with Him in the heavenly *places* in Christ Jesus,

2. Believers are to be kind to one another.

#### Romans 12:10 (NASB)

 $^{10}Be$  devoted to one another in brotherly love; give preference to one another in honor.

Ephesians 4:32 (NASB)

<sup>32</sup>Be kind to one another, tender-hearted, forgiving each other, just as God in Christ also has forgiven you.

Colossians 3:12 (NASB)

<sup>12</sup> So, as those who have been chosen of God, holy and beloved, put on a heart of compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness and patience.
2 Peter 1:5-7 (NASB)

<sup>5</sup> Now for this very reason also, applying all diligence, in your faith supply moral excellence, and in *your* moral excellence, knowledge, <sup>6</sup> and in *your* knowledge, self-control, and in *your* self-control, perseverance, and in *your* perseverance, godliness,

<sup>7</sup> and in *your* godliness, brotherly kindness, and in *your* brotherly kindness, love.
