What We Teach

THE CHURCH

We teach that all who place their faith in Jesus Christ are immediately placed by the Holy Spirit into one united spiritual Body, the church (<u>1 Corinthians 12:12-13</u>), the bride of Christ (<u>2 Corinthians 11:2</u>; <u>Ephesians 5:23-32</u>; <u>Revelation 19:7-8</u>), of which Christ is the Head (<u>Ephesians 1:22</u>; <u>Ephesians 4:15</u>; <u>Colossians 1:18</u>).

We teach that the formation of the church, the Body of Christ, began on the Day of Pentecost (<u>Acts 2:1-21</u>, <u>38-47</u>) and will be completed at the coming of Christ for His own at the rapture (<u>1</u> <u>Corinthians 15:51-52</u>; <u>1 Thessalonians 4:13-18</u>).

We teach that the church is thus a unique spiritual organism designed by Christ, made up of all born-again believers in this present age (Ephesians 2:11-3:6). The church is distinct from Israel (1 Corinthians 10:32), a mystery not revealed until this age (Ephesians 3:1-6; Ephesians 5:32).

We teach that the establishment and continuity of local churches is clearly taught and defined in the New Testament Scriptures (<u>Acts 14:23, 27</u>; <u>Acts 20:17, 28</u>; <u>Galatians 1:2</u>; <u>Philippians</u> <u>1:1</u>; <u>1 Thessalonians 1:1</u>; <u>2 Thessalonians 1:1</u>) and that the members of the one spiritual Body are directed to associate themselves together in local assemblies (CF.<u>1 Corinthians 11:18-</u> <u>20</u>; <u>Hebrews 10:25</u>).
